Session 1

Going after the Heart

We recognise that lasting change in the lives of young people comes from the heart, and so we want to encourage young people to develop a heart-level connection with Jesus and with others.


This session will explore how we can protect, nurture and encourage young people's hearts, whilst avoiding emotional manipulation.
