Pray for our nation

- 1. That we will rediscover Christ and our faith in Him will be restored; basing life and wellbeing on biblical principles, and faith in Jesus Christ
- 2. That those in positions of power, such as, politicians, business, community, and church leaders will know all authority is from God
- 3. That the moral, spiritual, and motivational fabric of society will re-acknowledge God in society

Pray for your Community

- 1. That peace and love will be society, restored in as demonstrated by Jesus through His people
- 2 That there would he reconciliation and a restoration in the value of human life
- 3. That God will raise up people to shine the light and love of Jesus across every stratum of society.

Pray for all generations

- 1. That the hearts of the children and young people be restored to the fathers and mothers in society
- 2. That the generations would develop a deeper respect for each other, acknowledging zeal wisdom
- 3. That the value of life from conception to elders be upheld in a 14 way which glorifies God



Pray for our friends and family who are yet to know Jesus

- 1. That divine appointments would be ordered by the Holy Spirit for their eternal salvation
- 2. That revelation of Jesus salvation and healing come to those addicted, selfdamaged, and seekina
- 3. That there would be significant progress in praying forwards for those we are concerned about

Pray for the 'Prodigals' to return

- 1. For restoration and healing for those who once had faith, or were influenced by church in the past
- 2. For God to intervene in the lives of those who have been hurt. disillusioned, or rejected
- 3. For opportunities to invite people friends and family to know Jesus, and connect at special events and accessible gatherings
