CHARGE TO MINISTERS:

All Christians are called to make Jesus Christ known as Saviour and Lord of all people, but you are being set apart in a particular way as a servant of the Lord Jesus Christ. You are to keep the Good Shepherd always before you as the pattern of your calling as you proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ to all. You are to shepherd, teach, and proclaim afresh, the faith that comes to us from the Apostles as recorded in Holy Scripture.

As the duly appointed representative of the Elim Pentecostal Church and as your colleague in Christ, I put to you the following challenges and request your public response.

- Recognising its high and holy call, do you believe that you are truly called to the Christian Ministry?
- Valuing the privilege and responsibility of Christian ministry, do you dedicate your time and talents to serving the people of all ages committed to your charge and to reaching the communities among whom you will minister with the Gospel?
- The Church is the people of God, the body of Christ, the temple of the Holy Spirit. Will you endeavour to promote unity, peace, and love among those you serve?
- Believing that the Holy Scriptures, the inspired Word of God, are sufficient in all matters of teaching, doctrine, good conduct, and discipleship, will you be a diligent Minister and teacher of the Word of God? Will you devote yourself to prayer and the study of it? Will you, with your household, order your life in accordance with the teachings of Scripture?
- Will you develop this calling to ministry through prayer and training, growing in competence and stature as a Christian Minister?

- Do you affirm loyalty to Christ's Church, and particularly to the Elim Pentecostal Church, subscribing without reservation to its foundational truths and submitting to its Constitution and its discipline? Will you lead by encouragement and example? Do you pledge faithfulness in prayer, preparation, and a lifestyle consistent with Christian ministry?
- Recognising a commitment to Elim nationally beyond the local church or personal ministry, do you commit to fully participate in all that is required of a Minister at regional and national level and to promote the vision and values of the Elim movement? Will you accept the discipline of Elim and give due respect to those set in authority over you?
- You cannot fulfil this ministry in your own strength. May the Lord who has given you the will to undertake this work, give you also the strength and power to perform it. Welcoming the Holy Spirit's empowering for ministry, do you commit to continual dependence upon His guidance, anointing and fullness?

Connie and her husband have served in Sheffield Central for a number of years but Connie's call has always been to Chaplaincy, especially with the healthcare in NHS. In July 2021 Connie was accepted as an Elim Network Minister in Training as a Chaplain. She holds a BA in Christian Leadership & Biblical Studies (Mattersey Hall Bible College - 2011), and a Masters in Healthcare Chaplaincy (Leeds Beckett University - 2016), and is also a registered member of the UK Board of Healthcare Chaplaincy (UKBHC). Connie was accepted as an Elim Network Minister in January 2025 and continues to serve as a Lead Chaplain at Barnsley Foundation NHS Trust Hospital.



DEBORAH BULLOCK

Debbie has served in ministry alongside her husband John, an EFGA Minister, for over 30 years in a number of our churches and on the mission field in Tanzania. They have a son, Christopher, an EFGA MIT, and a daughter, Bethany, and Debbie's father, Jim Thompson, is one of our Retired Ministers so she is truly Elim. Having graduated from Regents College in 2015 with an MA in Applied Theology, Debbie was accepted as a Minister in Training in January 2021 and appointed to Kingdom Life Church Newcastle Upon Tyne.
